

#### **Kit Instructions**

3 Easy Steps and 4 Important Rules

### 1. Print Your Photo on our patented FOTOFAB FABRIC™:

- Trial Run: Using one of the template sheets, print your favorite digital image or photo to an 8" x 10" size. See template sheet. DO NOT TRIM. It's necessary to have a full 8 1/2" x 11" sheet to insure the template FITS under the ribbon "FRAME". Slip your printed template sheet under the ribbon frame edging on the front of pillow to make sure placement is correct. Using the practice templates, print and adjust as many times as necessary to make sure your printed image fits into the ribbon frame the way you would like. Once you are satisfied with the position of your template image, it is time to print your image onto the FOTOFAB FABRIC™. (You can now remove the template. It's used for printing position only, for the final printing on the fabric sheet.)
- Pillow Pics ...
- **Printing:** First, prepare the **FOTOFAB FABRIC™**. Make sure the fabric is flat. Dust off or trim any loose threads. Keep your printer properties set at the *Plain Paper Setting-Best Mode*. Do not force a fabric sheet into your printer. Place the sheet flush against the paper guide. Insert the fabric in the way designated for your printer, so the fabric side becomes the printed side. Feed only one sheet at a time. Don't worry; two sheets of photo fabric are included.
- Optional Sealing the fabric photo: If desired, spray the fabric lightly with ScotchGard<sup>TM</sup>. This can be repeated a second time. Do not over saturate. Let the fabric dry thoroughly before mounting into front of pillow sham. (See FAQ's on cleaning instructions)

## 2. Mounting your printed FOTOFAB FABRIC™ into the front pocket of the pillow sham:

• Slip your printed printed photo fabric under the ribbon frame edging on the front of pillow- just like you did with the template. Please make sure the fabric and photo image extends beyond the visual opening far enough under the ribbon frame to allow a secure hold.

#### 3. Finishing your pillow:

- Keeping your printed fabric in place, lift the ribbon frame and remove the paper backing on the underside of the ribbon frame.
- Using an iron setting for silk, iron down the ribbon frame to secure the printed fabric into the pillow sham. USE DRY SETTING ONLY NO STEAM! IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO NOT USE AN OVERLY HOT IRON, AS THIS WILL DAMAGE THE RIBBON AND THE SHAM. An ironing cloth is included. Place the ironing cloth over the pillow. Let the iron set on the ironing cloth over the ribbon for 2 minutes (120 seconds) to soften the adhesive. This must be done for the ribbon to fuse. Go back and iron edges well to secure adhesive. (If there is any accidental scorching, this can be removed with vinegar.)



- For any edges make sure you do the ironing as instructed.
- From the back of the pillow sham, open the flap, and fill with the pillow stuffing. You're done!

# **4 IMPORTANT RULES**

- 1. Use practice paper templates, to insure alignment of image.
  - 2. Do not trim **FOTOFAB FABRIC™** unless necessary to fit.
    - 3. Use proper heat settings and ironing cloth
      - 4. Never leave iron unattended
